



How to claim your Bush Hog Salesperson Bonus:

1.) If you have already received a Reloadable Card skip to # 3 If you have not received a card Complete a W9 with legal name (NO business name) and Physical address (P.O Box can be included for mailing purposes in the box to the right) and a completed claim form and Warranty Registration of Eligible Products. It can be E-mail to the address below.

2.) Your Reloadable Visa Card will be mailed to the address you provided on your W9. It will take 8 to 10 working days to arrive. Please look at all mail it will look like junk mail!! When your card arrives, you must activate your card for use and future reloads. **(DO NOT throw your card away it will be used for all Salesperson Bonus Programs throughout the year)**

You can also sign up on the Netspend website after activation and it will send you text and/or emails when your card has been loaded. (www.netspend.com/account/register)

What's New

New line 3b has been added to this form. A flow-through entity is required to complete this line to indicate that it has direct or indirect foreign partners, owners, or beneficiaries when it provides the Form W-9 to another flow-through entity in which it has an ownership interest. This change is intended to provide a flow-through entity with information regarding the status of its indirect foreign partners, owners, or beneficiaries, so that it can satisfy any applicable reporting requirements. For example, a partnership that has any indirect foreign partners may be required to complete Schedules K-2 and K-3. See the Partnership Instructions for Schedules K-2 and K-3 (Form 1065).

By completing this online registration I am certifying that:

Hydraulic Machines: I have explained to the purchaser the necessity of using clean hydraulic oil, changing filters as instructed, the potential hazard of oil penetrating the skin and to not use bare hands to check for oil leaks, stopping leaks, maintaining the specified operating pressure, and the potential damage that can occur from operating with overheated oil.

Operator's Manual: I have shown the purchaser that the Operator's Manual is in the manual canister on the equipment and instructed the purchaser to read and understand the manual before operating the equipment. I instructed the purchaser that if he does not understand any of the instructions in the manual to ask this dealership to explain the instructions.

Power Transmission Shields: I have made certain that the driveline, gearbox, and other shields are in place and in good repair. I also explained the importance of maintaining these shields in place and in good condition to reduce the potential for serious personal injury.

If Applicable for Mowers Thrown Object Shields: I have explained to the purchaser that deflectors, chain guards, solid skirts must be maintained in good repair to reduce the potential for mower thrown objects. I have explained that it is not possible to guard against thrown objects if the mower heads is raised off the ground and that the operator is responsible for watching for persons and to stop mowing if a person comes within 300 feet of the mower.

If Applicable for Mowers: I have shown and given to the purchaser the AEM Mower Safety Practices Video.
